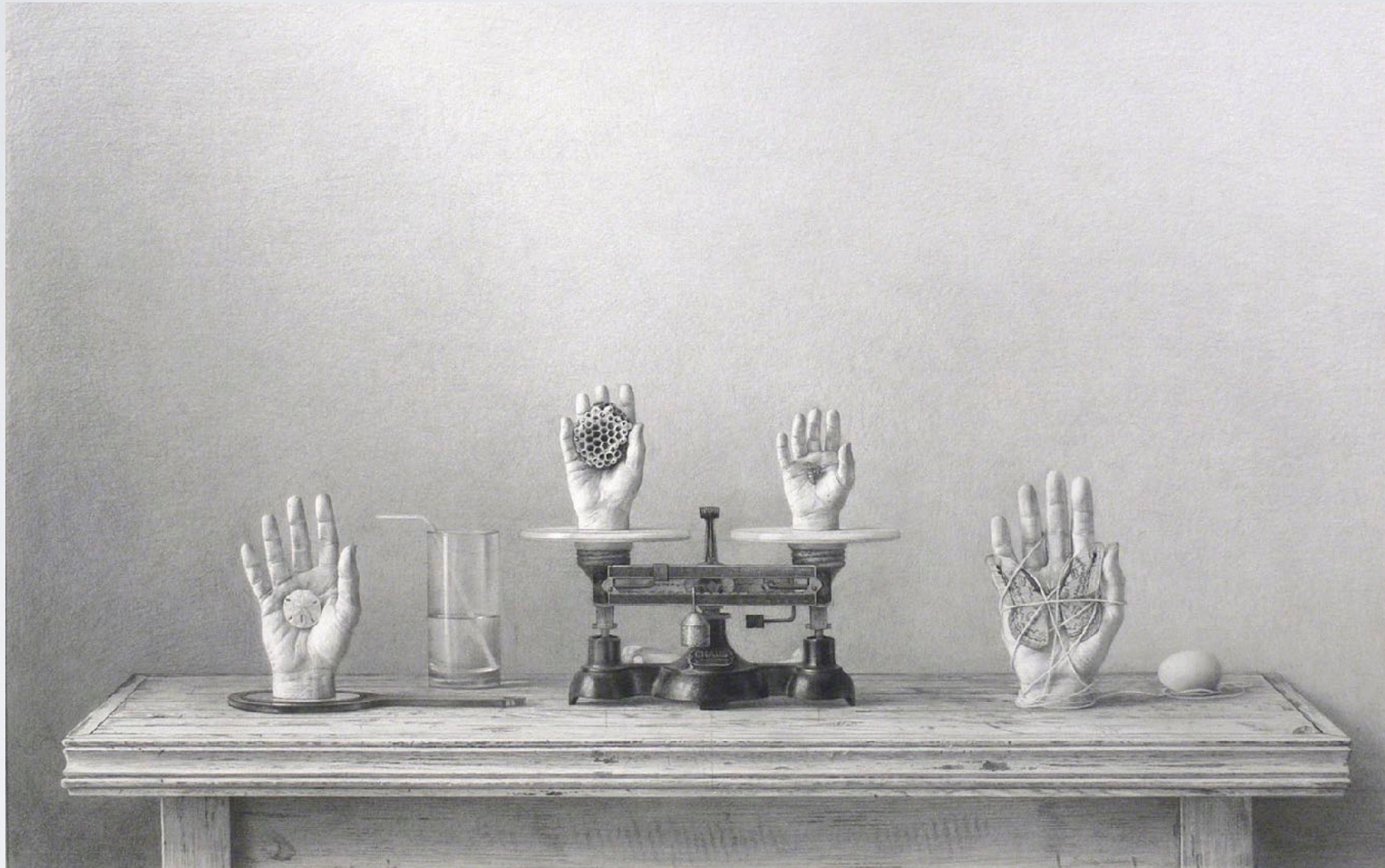

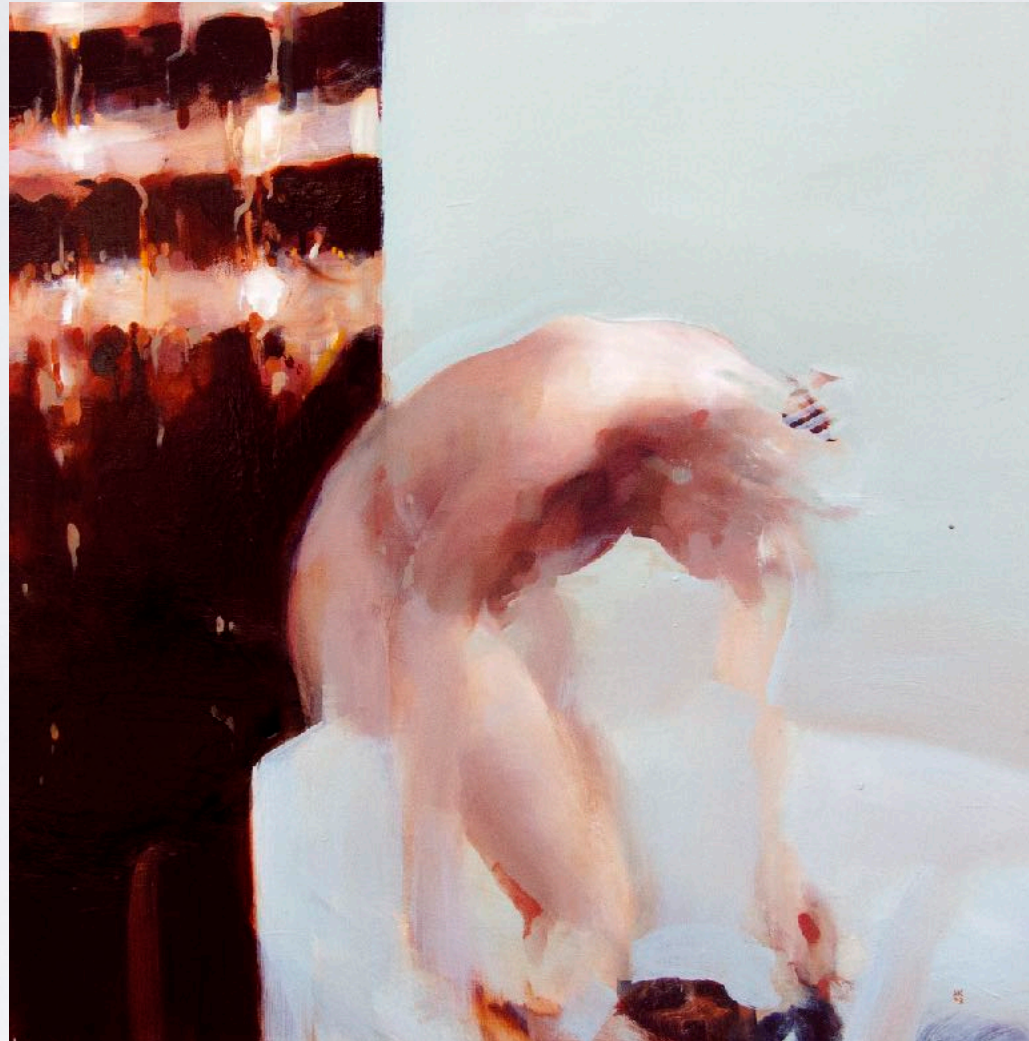

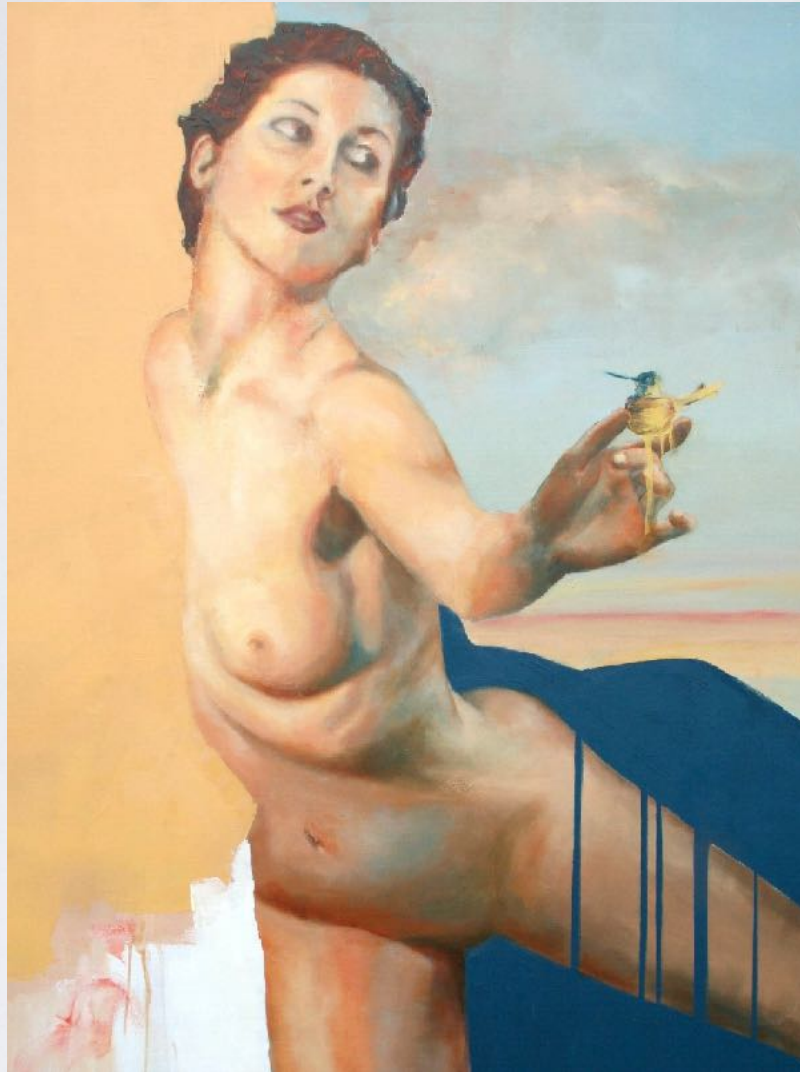

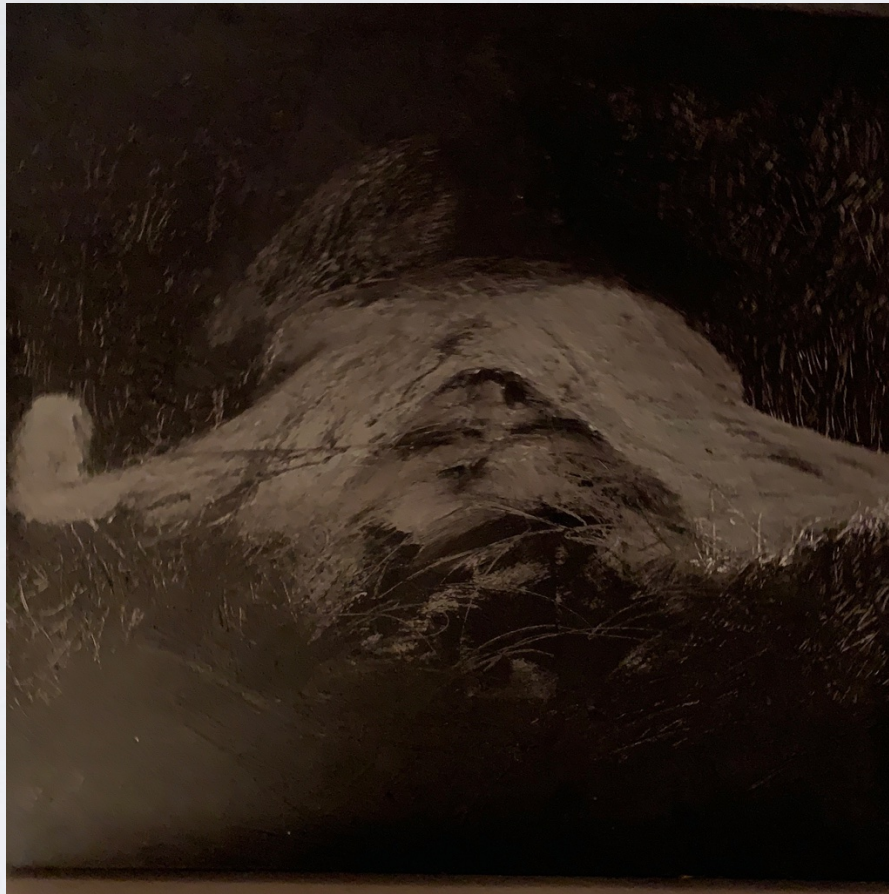

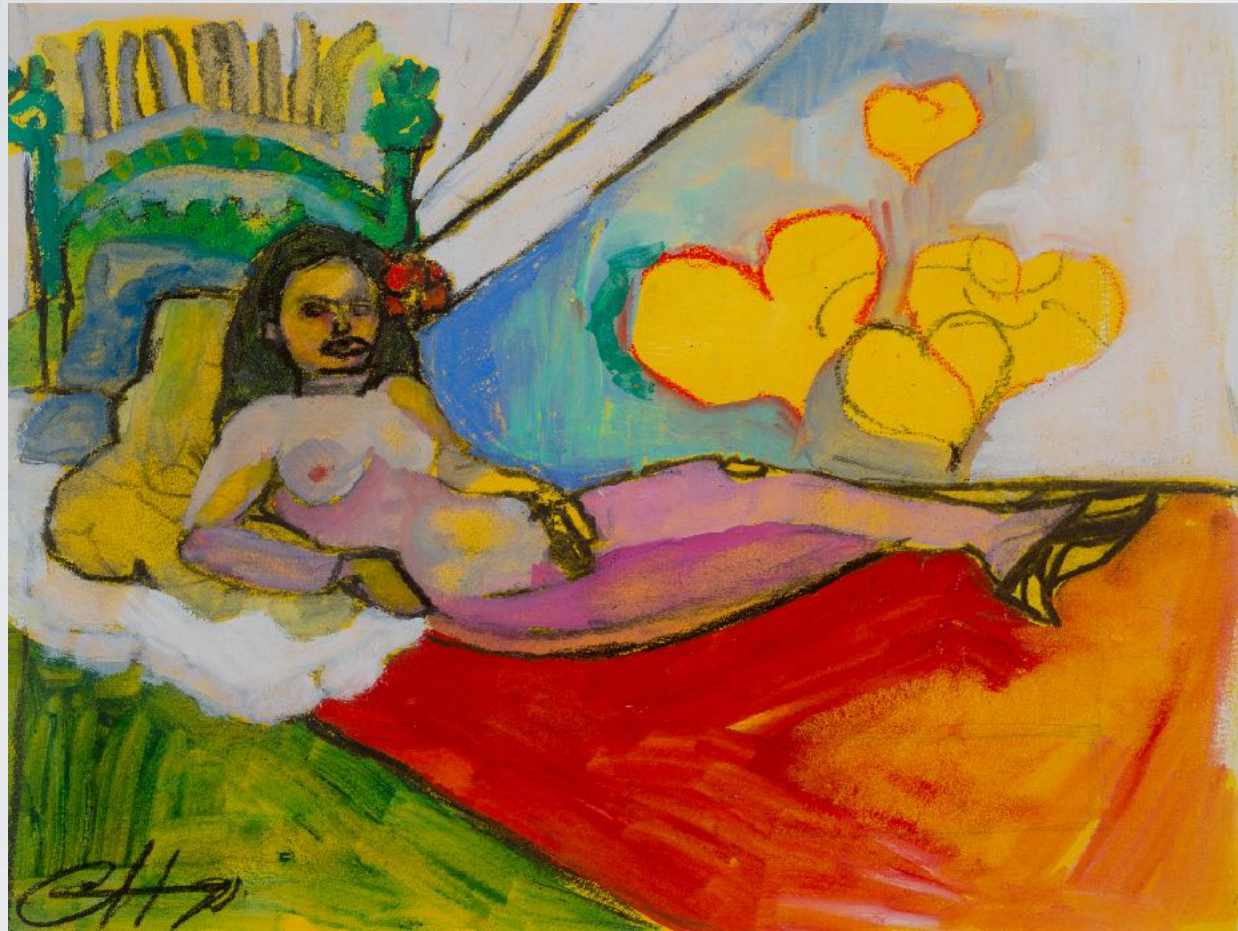

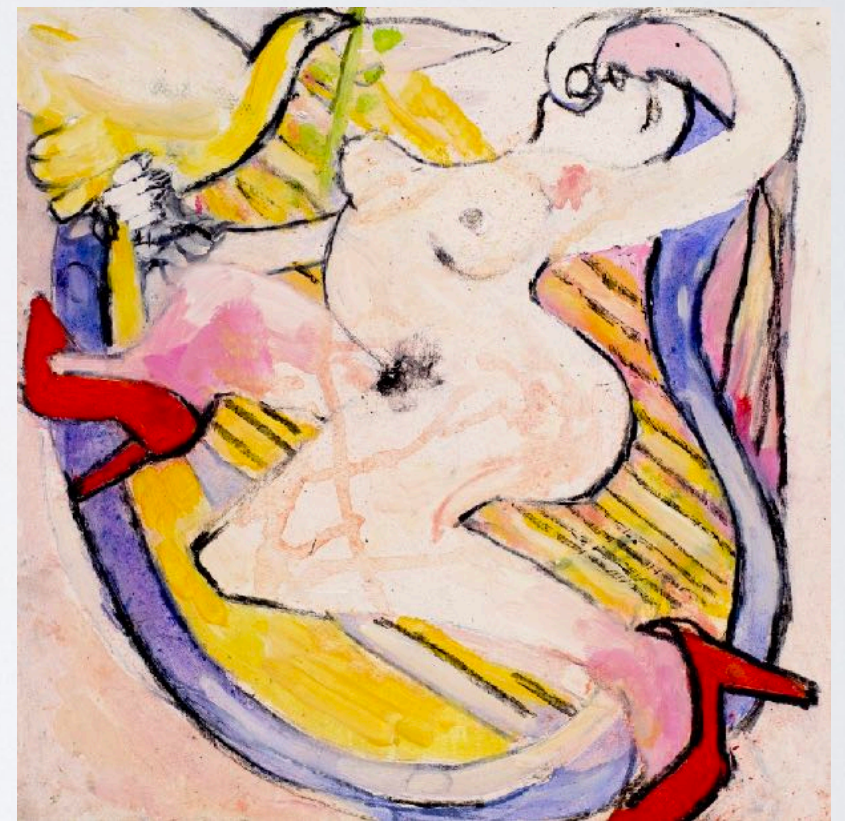

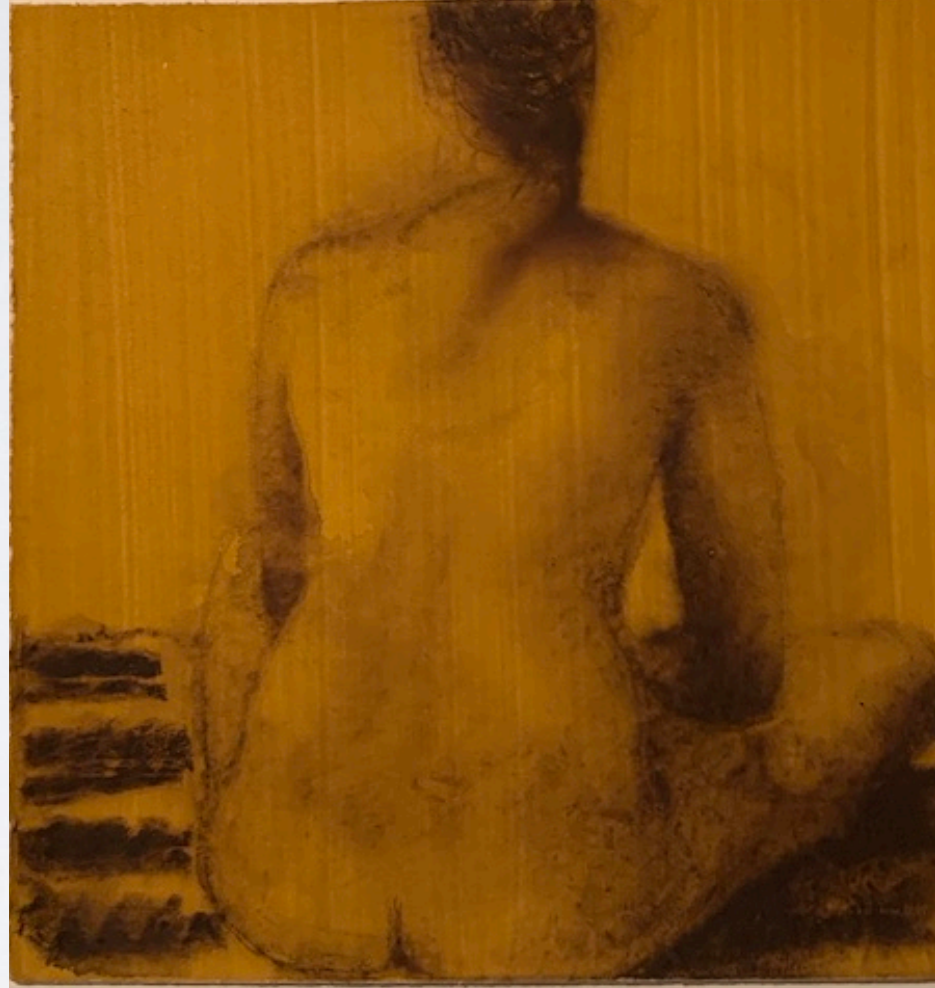

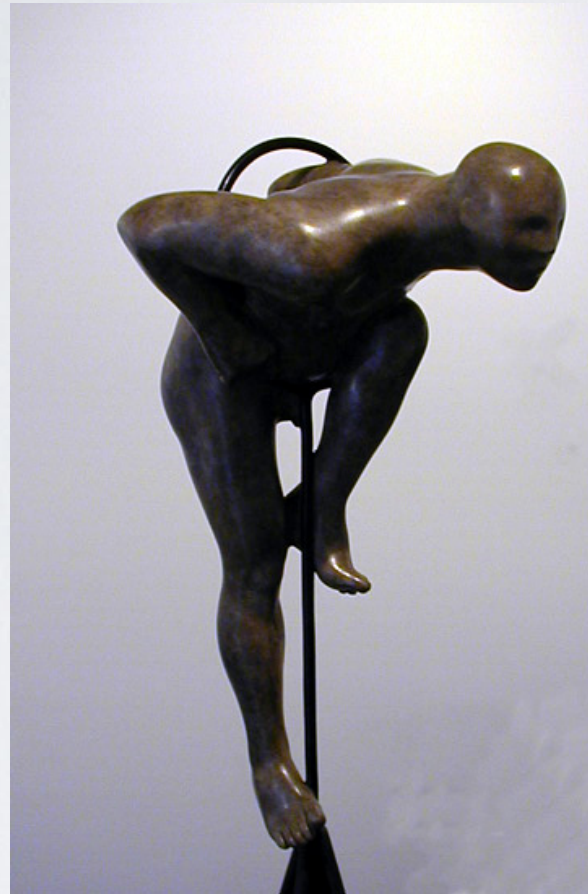

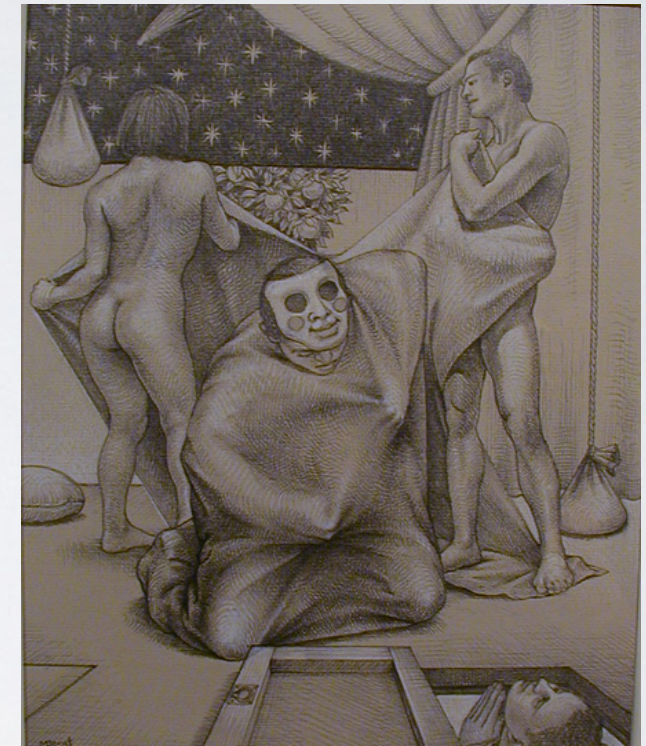

Surrogates for the human figure, the pieces of clothing in Fischer's paintings imply both human presence and its absence.

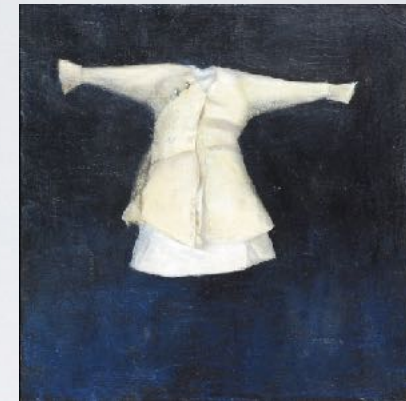
